Effective **January 1, 2023**, the City of Lufkin, Texas will begin utilizing the services of TecNXS, LLC. and its electronic reporting system, **AquaResource**, to track annual backflow testing.

The cost to testers to submit a <u>passing</u> backflow test on your behalf is \$6.00 per passing test.

Tester Recertification

All certifications/recertifications and licenses must be uploaded via the AquaResource site. Testers with expired backflow and/or equipment calibration certifications will be unable to upload passing backflow tests to the AquaResource site until the updated certification information is uploaded, reviewed, and approved.

Tester may enter new devices / replaced devices in the system while on site.
