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The City of Lufkin established a Continuing Capital Improvements

Program (CIP) in 1999, outlining equipment purchases and construction projects to be funded through bonds, operating revenues, grants and other funding mechanisms. Relocation of Fire Station #4 from 2815 South John Redditt, to a more efficient area was one of the objectives of the CIP long range plan. The purchase of a new aerial ladder truck in 2006 prompted the City to move forward with relocation of the fire station as none of the existing stations were large enough to house the new ladder truck. Property was purchased in March 2006, and the design phase of the new Station #4 project was implemented. Construction on the new facility began in 2007 and it was completed in April, 2008. The total cost of the new facility was \$1,103.894.
