

Ellen Trout Zoo's Jr. Zookeeper is a competitive program designed to provide students going into the seventh, eighth and ninth grades an opportunity to explore a career path in a zoological facility. This program accepts ten students in the June session (June 12-23) and ten students in the July session (July 10-21). Applicants must apply, have a teacher recommendation, write an essay about why they wish to participate in the program and be interviewed by a panel of zoo staff.

Participants will be able to request two of the four work areas in which to work.
