



Ellen Trout Zoo's Jr. Zookeeper is a competitive program designed to provide students going into the seventh, eighth, and ninth grades an opportunity to explore a career path as a zookeeper. If selected, students may participate in the program for a maximum two years.

This program accepts **ONLY** ten students per session:

Session 1: June 14-18 & 21-25, 2021 from 8:30 am - 12 noon, each weekday

Session 2: July 12-16 & 19-23, 2021 from 8:30 am - 12 noon, each weekday

Participants will be able to work in two of the five animal care sections at the zoo to assist zoo staff with daily animal care of the animals and habitats. The five animal care sections and animals in that section are:

<p>Mammals South: Hippos, Malayan Tapirs, White-tail deer, Bay duikers, West African crowned cranes, African Aviary, South American aviary, Bennett's wallabies, Emus, African tortoises, Bald eagles and the waterfowl pool</p>	<p>Herps: (reptiles & amphibians dept) all of the Small Animal Building animals (snakes, lizards, amphibians), American Alligators, Galapagos tortoises, Komodo Dragons, Siamese and Nile crocodiles and large Asian pythons</p>
<p>Asia/Primates: Cotton- top tamarins, DeBrazza's monkeys, Black and white ruffed lemurs, White-faced saki monkey, a variety of parrot species, Toco toucan, Chilean flamingos, Clouded leopards, Blackbuck, Asian Aviary, African crested porcupines, Raccoon, Chinese alligators and Tawny frogmouths</p>	<p>Mammals North: African Lions, Malayan Tiger, Jaguars, Southern White Rhinos, Maasai Giraffes, vet clinic animals, Bobcat, Bontebok, Abyssinian Ground hornbill, Egyptian geese, Linnes' two-toed sloths, Cotton-top tamarins, North American river otter, several raptor species, and Jamacian fruit bats</p>
<p>Education (Ambassador Animals): Virginia opossum, Eastern screech owl, Domestic rabbit. 3 species of snakes, Broad-nosed caimans, Pancake tortoise, Common snapping turtle, and 2 species of amphibians. Jr. Zookeepers in this section will also assist with Zoo Safari summer camp.</p>	

Deadlines and requirements to apply

Due **March 19th, 2021** by 5:00 pm:

- Completed application
- Teacher recommendation
- A full one-page essay written by the applicant describing why they would make the best candidate for the Junior Zookeeper program, including any relevant skills and experience

Applicants with all appropriate materials submitted by the deadlines, will be contacted for an interview on Friday, April 9th or Saturday, April 10th, 2021.
